New Metal Detector Protocol- Step by Step Beginning Monday Jan 10, 2022

Entering the building:

- 1. Any items that are metal and that are usually in a student's backpack like laptop, 3-ring binders with metal spine, cell phone, keys, protractor, metal pens, rulers, etc. will be kept in a separate plastic ziploc bag. Large 14"x20" clear resealable bags with the student's name will be distributed this week.
- 2. These clear bags should be removed from the backpack *prior* to entering the building.
- 3. Student enters the lobby with backpack on.
- 4. Clear bag is placed on the table prior to walking through the metal detector.
- 5. Staff will monitor ziploc bags and bins and slide them forward.
- 6. Student walks through the metal detector with their backpack on.

If There is No Alarm:

- 1. Student retrieves their clear bag
- 2. Continues to class

If There is an Alarm:

- 1. Security will wand student to determine what is setting off alarm
- 2. If this *can be* concluded quickly in public view (belt buckle, for example), the student may retrieve belongings and go to class.
- 3. If this *cannot* be concluded quickly, further screening will be done by security at a separate table in the lobby. This will include both a wanding of the student and a bag search.
 - a. If it is determined that the alarm was set off by a belt or similar item, the student will retrieve items and go to class.
 - b. If the alarm was set off by something allowed, remind the student to place this in the clear bag for the next day.
 - c. If a prohibited item is found, the security guard should alert an administrator.
