## **Research Projects**

The Board of Education recognizes that worthy educational values may be served by permitting independent research projects to be carried out in the schools. The Superintendent, or his/her designee, may approve research proposals and so inform the Board of Education. Those of a sensitive nature will be reviewed by the Board of Education. All research projects must:

- 1. preserve the privacy of all individuals,
- 2. promote professional interest,
- 3. significantly contribute to the body of knowledge about education,
- 4. refrain from using the results for commercial or private gain, and
- 5. not interfere with the instructional process or take undue time away from it.

A copy of the research report will be submitted to the Superintendent of Schools.
