## AN INTRODUCTION TO SBAC

#### HPS District SBAC Letter

The SBAC summative assessment (from the Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium) is a standardized test that is aligned to the Common Core State Standards, also known as the Common Core.

These standards emerged in 2010, as part of a national educational initiative centered on what American students, grades K-12, should know in math and English Language Arts (ELA) at the close of each grade. The Common Core are consistent standards across states that ensure our children are ready for high school, higher education, and the workplace.

The SBAC, used for the first time in May of 2015, is an adaptive, online assessment, which is given in several states, including Connecticut, and also uses automated essay scoring. Students in grades 3 through 8 and 11 take this summative assessment for math and ELA, including a Performance Task (PT) and a Computer-Adaptive Test (CAT) in both subjects.

#### Why is SBAC important?

Each assessment is scored on a scale of 1 to 4:

- 4 Standard Exceeded
- 3 Standard Met
- 2 Standard Nearly Met
- 1 Standard Not Met

SBAC scores gauge school performance, guide curriculum and school-based initiatives, and support responsive instruction that meets each child's learning needs. By high school graduation, the SBAC has helped students to better meet the demands of post secondary education, training, and the workplace.

At more than 200 colleges and universities in seven states, SBAC scores are accepted to determine a student's readiness for college courses. When a student scores at level 3 or 4 on the SBAC, a high school grad is "college and career ready" and may skip remedial courses and enroll in credit-bearing college classes.

#### When will SBAC be administered at Hamden Middle School?

Year-end summative assessments begin at HMS the week of April 25th and continue through the close of May. 8th graders will also take the NCSS summative assessment in science. Be sure to mark your calendars with the testing schedule below:
