SBAC TESTING

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Your child will participate in the annual state assessments in English Language Arts and Mathematics by taking the Smarter Balanced Assessments, or the Connecticut Alternate Assessment (CTAA) for eligible students. Students in grades 5, 8, and 11 will also be tested in science by taking the Next Generation Standards Science Assessment (NGSS) or the Connecticut Alternate Science Assessment (CTAS).

Student reports will be sent home to parents and guardians in early fall. You can use the results to see what your child knows and what skills they can demonstrate based on the state grade-level standards taught in the classroom and measured on the state assessments.

All of these standardized assessments are administered online over multiple sessions. These assessments are designed to measure skills in reading comprehension, writing, mathematics, and real-world science using questions that require students to demonstrate a true understanding of content. Additional supports are available for students with special needs in all of these statewide assessments, as determined by an individualized education program (IEP) or 504 Plan.
