SPECTATOR POLICY

Parents/Guardians for outdoor sports may attend only home events at this time. We still have a *no spectators policy* for indoor events. Boys and Girls Soccer, Field Hockey and Football - parents/guardians should have received 2 passes for parents/guardians to show when they come to a game. You will need to show the actual pass and not a picture of it. It will only work for events that your son/daughter is participating in. The passes are numbered. There will be no re-issuing of passes for lost passes. We are doing our best to keep our athletes, coaches and staff safe.

LIVE STREAMING

I am happy to finally report we have the livestream up and running. The video is looking very good. Currently, the sound and score keeping features are still being worked out and each sport is in a different place with it. Please share the link with others who may be interested in watching the game and are unable to attend. You can subscribe to the NFHS Network for \$10.99 a month (Billed monthly. Cancel at anytime) or \$69.99/year - a 47% discount by clicking the *subscribe* button. That gives you access to watch all games that take place on the network including games at away schools that have the same system. This will cover games on the turf fields such as football, field hockey, soccer, lacrosse, baseball/softball (possibly) and indoor sports such as volleyball and basketball that take place in the HHS gym.

There is a 4-minute delay from the actual game time. We have started the cameras earlier than the anticipated game time so everyone can sign on and view the game. Please do not be alarmed in warm-ups when the camera is scanning back and forth. The cameras detect the balls moving when it films. The cameras will be operational as long as our internet at our school is operational. Any issue in service to our school will affect our ability to livestream the event.

We appreciate everyone's patience with getting this up and running. Hopefully, everyone gets to enjoy their sons and daughters playing now.
