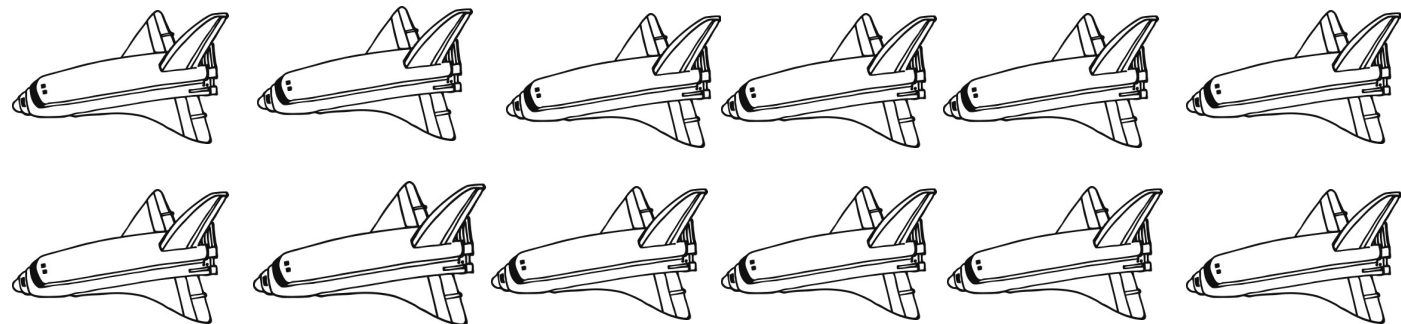

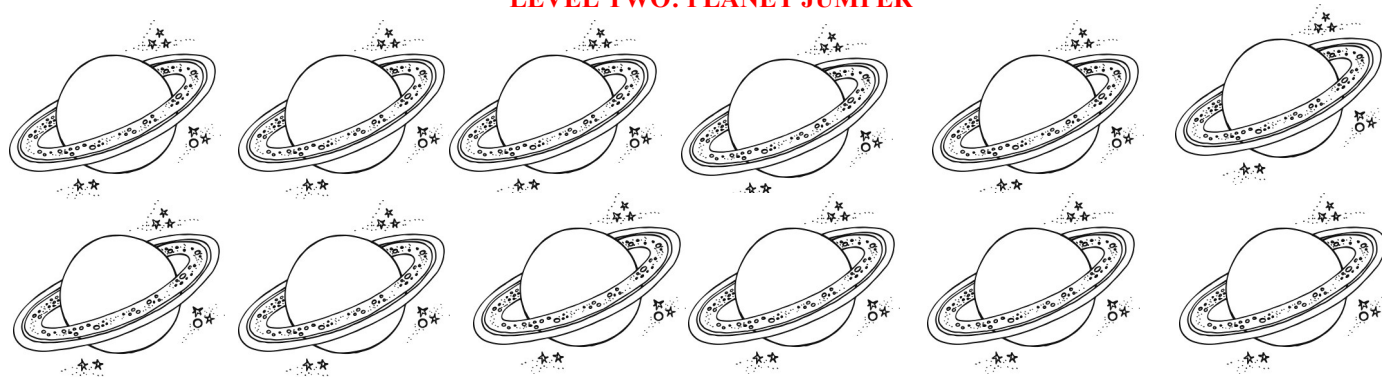

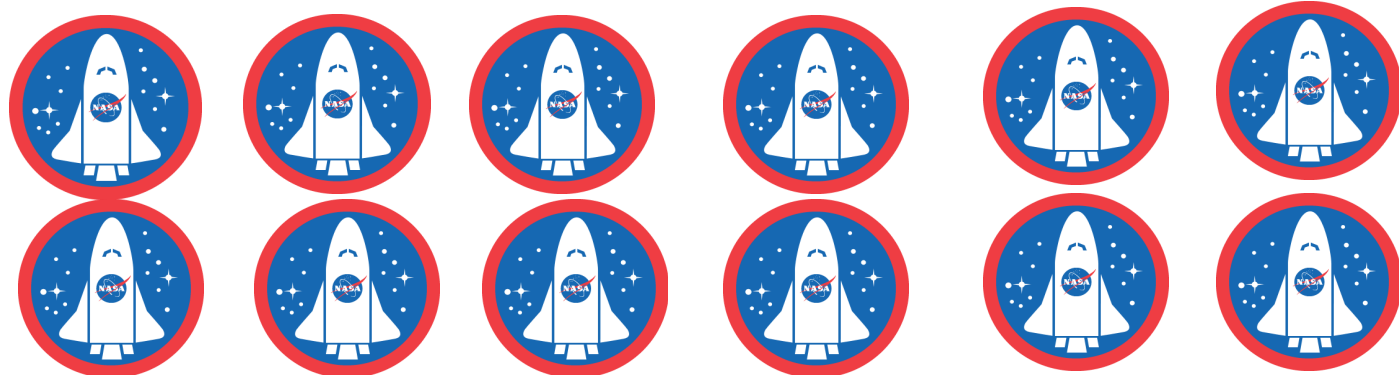
LEVEL TWO: PLANET JUMPER
