Dear Parent or Guardian:

Our local prevention coalition, **the Hamden Youth Network** is the recipient of a grant to assist the community in identifying current factors that influence the healthy and positive development of our children and youth. A variety of community resources have joined together to form **the Hamden Youth Network** with the goal of reducing substance use among the youth of **Hamden**.

To move forward in addressing the needs of our community, we need better information about our youth and their attitudes and behaviors regarding substance use and abuse. The **Hamden** Survey is a computer-driven survey intended to provide **the Hamden Youth Network** with data about the youth in our community and the factors that influence them. With this information, our community can plan strategies and programs that strive to increase protective factors, and decrease risk factors.

The survey will be administered to students in **grades 6, 8 and 10 the week of April 25 through the week of May 9th.** Students will be asked to voluntarily participate in this brief survey during one class period at school. The survey is both anonymous and confidential and students will not be asked for their names or any identifying information. Results will be provided only as a summary of responses. A copy of the survey is available for you to review at your principal's office. If you would like your child excluded from the survey, please contact your teacher in writing on or before April 25th.
