

*** WINTER SPORTS UPDATE**

Winter sports registration is open. If interested, please sign up on FamilyID through our website www.hamden.org > click the **Athletics** tab. Coaches will not be able to contact student athletes unless they are signed up for their sport.

Approved Winter sports will start on Tuesday, January 19, 2021.

All student athletes need to be approved to participate. This means everyone needs to be:

- Registered on familyID
- Cleared medically with the HHS Nurse
- Cleared academically with the Athletic Office (must pass 4 full credit classes)
- Parents and student athletes must have signed the winter athletic waiver.

If you are not cleared to participate, please contact the head coach as you will not be allowed to be in attendance.

Each coach for your athlete's program will send out information in regards to tryout procedures. In many cases cohorts will be established with no more than 15 student athletes for tryouts. Each cohort will be given instructions on how to enter and exit the facility. Parents/guardians need to pick up their athletes on time to avoid loitering at the school. Every parent/guardian must covid-symptom check their student athlete prior to arrival. If a student does not feel well or has covid-symptoms, please contact their coach immediately and stay home. Athletes and Coaches are required to wear a mask at all times. This includes pre/post practice, during practice and game play.

All student athletes will be required to:

- Wear a mask upon arrival
- Bring an extra clean face mask in case a replacement is needed
- Bring a large water bottle filled with water that will last you through your practice
- Wear proper attire for your sport. You should require very little changing to prepare for your tryout.
- Exit immediately after your practice is complete and go home to shower.
