



HHS Credit Recovery Summer 2021

Credit Recovery program is a computer-based online course that uses a self-taught curriculum. The program begins on June 28th and ends on August 6th from 9am until 11:30am. Students are expected to learn the material on their own with support of the teacher of record. A certified teacher will be available to help students understand the lessons, but will not help during tests. These teachers will monitor attendance as well as work completion. Both students and parents must sign the Credit Recovery Contract in order to participate in the program. Administrators reserve the right to dismiss a student from the Credit Recovery program at their discretion. Attendance is mandatory. If students are interested, they should contact their HHS counselor for more information about which courses they should take.

Eligibility

- Credit recovery is available to students who failed a course or lost credit in a course due to attendance.
- Courses in math, English, social studies, science and a variety of electives will be offered.
- Priority will be given based on anticipated graduation date and to students currently enrolled at Hamden High School.

Participation Information

- Both students and guardians must register and agree to the Credit Recovery Contract in order for the student to participate on Google Forms:

- Students must attend daily sessions in person from 9am-11:30pm. Students may also work on their courses at home with the exception of tests. (NOTE: This is HIGHLY encouraged)
- In order to remain in the program then they will need to stay on pace and complete at least two Tutorials and Mastery Tests per week.
- All students are expected to complete all assigned Course Activities as well as Discussions for each Unit.
- Students are required to take notes during lessons.
- A progress report will be sent weekly through email.
- Attendance is mandatory.
- Students who make no progress in their credit recovery classes will be withdrawn from the credit recovery program.
- Administration reserves the right to dismiss a student from the program at their discretion.
