



What's the Top Gift for 2018?




But according to the internet, the top toys of 2018 are WowWee Fingerlings Hugs, large stuffed monkeys that make noises when you

Hamden High School Alumni Basketball Game


On Friday November 9, 2018 Hamden High School hosted a women's Alumni basketball game. Hamden Middle's own Mrs. Morello participated in the event.

Here's a big question that's rarely asked: why do we eat turkey on Thanksgiving? Why is that such a big tradition for us in the U.S? Well, Pilgrims and Native Americans who first started Thanksgiving may not have eaten turkey. Although William Bradford noted that

the Pilgrims gathered wild fowl, he was most likely referring to duck and geese. However, turkeys were still in the Plymouth area. So when and how did the turkey tradition start? Well, Branford's journals from 1856 mentioned hunting for wild turkeys during the summer of 1621. Turkey is native to North America, which gained attention as the Thanksgiving meal choice after Lincoln declared Thanksgiving as a national holiday in 1863.
