

Medical Registration: The first page of the CT Health Assessment form should be completed by the parent/guardian and should be signed and dated. Pages two and four of the CT Health Assessment are completed by your child's Health Care Provider (within a year of start of school) and include immunizations. The third page is completed by your child's dentist.

Health History Questionnaire is to be completed by the parent/guardian. This form helps the nurse understand your child. This can be found in the online registration and is separate from the MD portion.

Providing information to the Health Office about special education services, a 504 plan, daily medications, or behavioral concerns can be very helpful to ensure a full and complete health history. This information can be included on the first page of the Health Assessment form. If needed, medical authorization forms and emergency plans for common health issues are available on the WWS Nurse's webpage (<https://www.hamden.org/westwoods/nurses-office>) for your child's medical provider to complete.

Children cannot go on field trips without their Asthma Action Plans or Emergency Care Plans if they have a diagnosis of an allergy, asthma, or seizures. Any responsible adult may deliver the medication and orders to the Health Office. Orders must be signed by parent / guardian and the supervising MD. No elementary student is permitted to carry any medications to school. (in middle school that may begin with an MD's order).

If your child has not had any asthma issues in 3 years or you're not sure if your child has a food allergy still, please speak with your pediatrician or allergist for a retest. Once the school has a note from an MD to remove the diagnosis, then a medication will no longer be required.

Lastly always keep a copy of your child's last physical, immunizations, and Emergency Plans in a zip lock bag in a safe place at home.
