Nonacademic and Extracurricular Activities

Our District ensures that in providing for nonacademic and extracurricular activities and services, each student with a disability participates with nondisabled students to the maximum extent appropriate to the needs of the student. The provision of these activities and services includes meals and recess periods. Other activities and services that are available to students with disabilities are counseling, athletics, transportation, health services, recreational activities, and special-interest groups or clubs sponsored by the District. Hamden also makes referrals to agencies that provide assistance to individuals with disabilities and employment of students, including employment by the District and assistance in making outside employment available.

Students with disabilities have available to them the variety of educational programs and services that are available to nondisabled students in our District. These programs and services include but are not limited to art, music, industrial arts, consumer education and vocational education.
